




Families Served in 2025



Ages of Individuals Served




Household Composition




FPDC 2025 Financial Overview

Family Promise 2025 Recap

As Family Promise of Davie County celebrates eight years of service, we reflect on the meaningful impact we've made for families facing housing crises in our community. Since opening our doors, we have remained committed to preventing homelessness whenever possible and, when crisis does occur, providing temporary shelter, transitional housing, and ongoing support to help families regain stability.

Our success is rooted in the strength of our community. Individual donors, local businesses, volunteers, and faith partners all play a vital role in making this work possible. Family Promise is truly a community-driven effort, and we would not be where we are today without the generosity and commitment of Davie County.

In 2025, we reached a major milestone—serving our 1,200th child. More than 1,200 children across over 755 families have experienced stability, care, and hope through our programs, and 93% of families remain stably housed one year after completing services—powerful evidence of the lasting impact of our work.

We know that stable housing, paired with compassionate support, can change the trajectory of a child's life. At Family Promise, we believe a child's future begins at home.

As we look ahead to 2026, we are energized to expand our reach and strengthen our programs. In the coming months, we will launch a capital campaign to build new facilities that will increase our capacity and allow us to serve more families in need. Together, we can create greater stability and brighter futures for children across our community.
